James is delighted to return to the Mac-Haydn for the second time after taking the title role in Jekyll and Hyde last season.

James has performed numerous roles in both opera and musical theatre including creating the role of Marco Polo in Christopher Cerrone's Invisible Cities in 2011. He is a passionate performer of the art song repertoire and a champion of new music. In February James appeared at Trinity Wall Street as part of the American Art Song Series, performing a program of songs by Richard Hundley. He also performed Schumann's Dichterliebe as part of a fundraiser for one of New York's premier choral ensembles, Musica Sacra.

Following his work at the Mac-Haydn this season, James is travelling to New Zealand to perform with the Southern Sinfonia and for a series of recitals with pianist Jillian Zack. He then joins Opera Omaha for their upcoming production of La Traviata.

James has just completed recording sessions for his debut album with renowned pianist Kenneth Merrill. The disc, Exiled: The Extrication of Kurt Weill, will be released in the fall of 2012.
